

Tax Credit

Qualifying Charitable Organizations: Lions Camp Tatiyee

Donate up to \$400 for couples filing jointly (\$200 for individuals) by or before the 31st of December via check

Itemize your deductions of Federal Schedule A

Your add back is done on Arizona Schedule A (Arizona will not permit you to take this as a deduction and a credit)

Submit tax forms with your Arizona Income Tax Filing (include tax forms 321 and 301)

On page one of Arizona form 140 you take a dollar-for-dollar credit. The State of Arizona will reduce the amount you owe in state taxes up to \$400

Include your donation among Charitable Contributions in filing your Federal Tax return.

He traveled throughout the state of Arizona enlisting the support of all the Arizona Lions to build and maintain a camp for challenged individuals so that more children and adults with special needs could enjoy a camping experience in the White Mountains. Through his efforts, Lions Camp Tatiyee was established in 1958.

To improve the emotional health of individuals with special needs, providing them an opportunity to interact with others having similar challenges with the goal of building their independence and self-confidence

Campers We Serve:

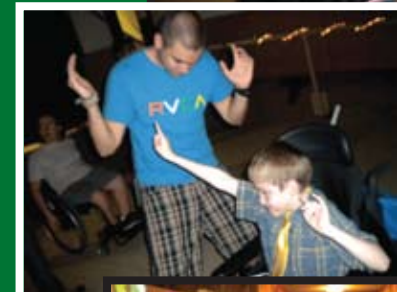
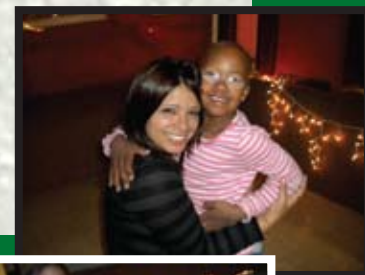
Camper age range is 7 years and up. Our sessions are divided by age with special sessions for physically challenged, mentally challenged, multi challenged, deaf and blind. Challenges have included but are not limited to spinal injury, cerebral palsy, spina bifida, muscular dystrophy, multiple sclerosis, amputees, deafness, blindness and mildly mentally challenged. Applications are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Due to the nature of Camp Tatiyee, we are unable to accommodate individuals with psychiatric, psychological, emotional or conduct disorders, or anyone exhibiting aggressive tendencies.

Fees:

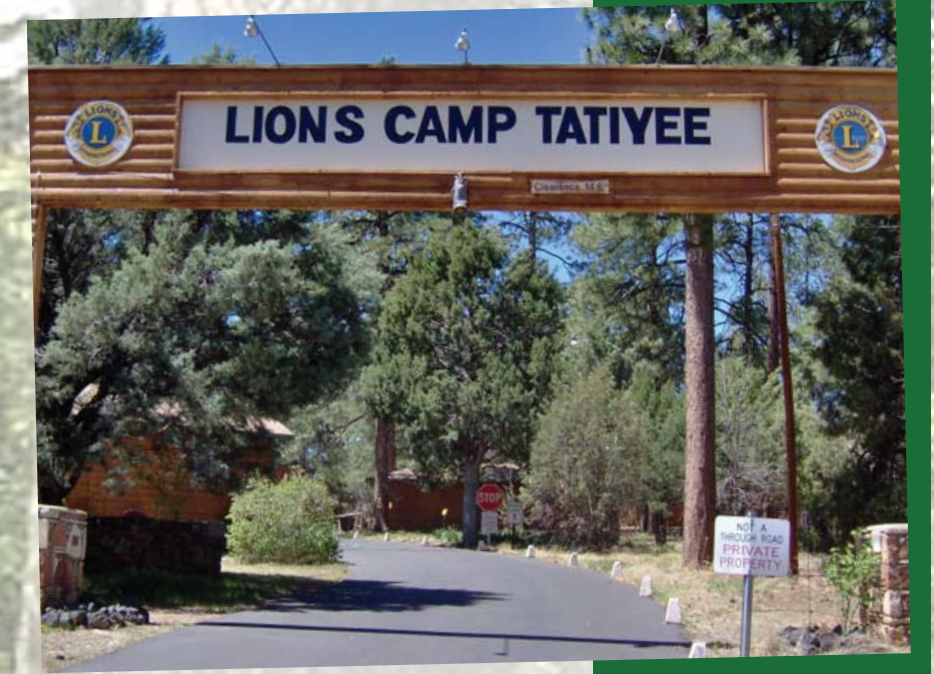
There are no fees to attend Lions Camp Tatiyee as a camper. We gladly accept donations. There are few requirements for potential campers: one is to have a current physical completed as part of our application process, and the other is to provide their own transportation to and from camp.

Staffing:

Recruiting is directed towards universities and colleges all over the United States. We look for those individuals who are pursuing a career or are in a field related to our clientele which include education, special education, physical therapy, social work, counseling, medical, recreation, etc. There are several positions for counselors-in-training (CIT) which are usually well directed high school individuals with whom we hope to develop into an experienced staff for following years. Food:

We want you to be nourished while visiting us in the White Mountains, by the fresh mountain air as well as with our tasty food. Work with our preferred caterer and camp staff to help create the appropriate menu for your event. We can offer inexpensive options starting as low as \$4.00 per person. If you are planning a more sophisticated meal or event, we can serve some of the best cuisine that the White Mountains has to offer. Inquire about our beautiful open air ramada to enjoy delicious meals in a gorgeous outdoor setting.



Location and Facilities:

Lions Camp Tatiyee is situated on 88 acres of beautiful Ponderosa Pine forest in the White Mountains of Arizona. Our nature trails take you meandering among mature pines, alligator junipers and pinons, and in the summer witness an array of colorful wildflowers. Experience the breathtaking vistas of the Mogollon Rim while exploring our pristine surroundings. While we want you to have an inspirational outdoor experience while visiting us, we also want you to be comfortable. Our facilities include 4 large handicap accessible cabins that sleep up to 25 people in bunk beds and up to 8 people in a smaller attached room. All cabins are equipped with community bathrooms, small dressers for storage, shelves, and plenty of windows for natural light. Also available are two private residential cabins. Each include a full kitchen, living room dining area, two bedrooms & one bath.

Our recently renovated 3,500 square foot Dining Hall seats up to 125 people. Adjacent to this building is a lounge area with foosball, ping pong and a pool table. The Recreation Hall includes a fully equipped theatrical stage and open space for seating or playing recreational games. Attached is an art room with tables and two sinks. Camp Tatiyee also offers an indoor heated pool that is 4.5 feet in depth at its deepest. This facility includes bathrooms and shower area.

Other features include an outdoor ramada and grill for barbecues, outdoor chapel, fire pit, Rosie's Pond with private fishing, handicapped accessible playground, swings, baseball field, sport court, and sound room. Audio/visual equipment – overhead projectors, multimedia projectors, podiums, TV/VCR/DVD, cordless microphones.

Reservations:

We are available to lease the camp from August through the 3rd week of May each year as our summer camp typically runs during June and July.
